Dear Parent/Guardian,

The Calgary Senior High School Athletics Association (CSHSAA) is very pleased that student athletes are able to participate in inter-school basketball and other extra-curricular activities this year. We are, however, only able to offer spectator access if all health measures continue to be followed. We have received a complaint that this is not always the case. The following health measures **MUST** continue to be followed:

- Face masks must be worn at all times
- Events are restricted to 1/3 fire code capacity limit
- Physical distancing must be practiced

To reinforce these health measures, **effective December 13, 2021**, the Calgary Board of Education (CBE) and the Calgary Catholic School District (CCSD) are implementing an Entry Pass system to ensure we comply with the 1/3 fire code capacity limit. Each student athlete will receive 4 Entry Passes for each game, which they may then distribute to family members that make up a household cohort.

Note: Jr High and High School aged students who are part of the family cohort must show school I.D.

As of January 4, 2022, at CBE schools, adult visitors and guests attending extra-curricular events including sporting events, performances and assemblies, must, prior to being admitted to the event, provide the designated CBE employee with proof of vaccination confirming they are fully immunized against COVID-19.

Please refer to CBE Administrative Regulation 1016 for further clarity.

We also remind you that no food or beverage may be consumed while in the school gymnasium.

We thank you for complying with the processes and protocols that will be in place to ensure we can continue to offer spectator access at these indoor events.
