On Friday, Pearson Model UN hosted the last conference of the year in the hollowed halls of the Murray Fraser Building, Faculty of Law at the University of Calgary. Our students chaired and ran two model international criminal courts, joint sessions of SCO (Shanghai Cooperation Organization) and NATO and The UN General Assembly. Our students led these sessions through debates, calling for points of order, amendments, advising delegates and guiding them through late braking international crises. The keynote speaker was, Sarah Aouchice, an expert in international law. Sarah served with the UNHRC, United Nations Refugee Agency. She led UN missions in refugee camps in war torn areas of the Middle East and Africa. The conference was outstanding and our students were exemplary in their preparation and leadership.
